To Whom It May Concern

The University Steinke Physical Education Center 400,000 gallon swimming pool surfaces and structure appeared to be in poor condition, and several consultants were brought in for an assessment to determine the need to either completely replace or repair the pool. The assessments concluded that the swimming pool surfaces had not been properly maintained, cleaned and re-grouted on a periodic renewal basis, and that the structure was basically sound. Due to the limited time available for scheduled classes, we hired a project consultant and a Job Order Contractor to begin work on cleaning, flashing, and tile replacements, as well as performing the replacement of various plumbing fixtures within the pool surfaces.

The consultant provided recommended swimming pool contractor listings based upon professional experience and services in the required areas of pool refurbishment, and we invited several in for their assessments and cost estimates. Atlantis Pool Plastering, Inc. representatives presented themselves professionally and exhibited the knowledge required to perform the work and they were hired as the pool subcontractor. They brought an expertise that was utilized in making multiple changes to the consultant's recommended repairs and refurbishment plans, thereby improving the finished product.

At one point the Job Order Contractor had hired another company to perform some tile replacement work, and the Project Manager for Atlantis Pool Plastering notified us that the work was obviously substandard, and they performed the demolition and replacement of that work to outstanding standards.

The Atlantis Pool Plastering, Inc. on-site representatives, project managers, and workers were professional in their attitudes, schedules, and job performance, and continue to provide outstanding Customer Services in addressing any user questions or concerns.
